Spook and Sip – October 29th Friday

SDL's all approved, glasses were delivered. Check in will be at the Belvedere starting at 6:15pm. Once everyone is registered, the Belvedere will turn into the after-party. No open containers. The drink needs to be gone prior to leaving your business. We will have 18 stops.

Tickets will be on sale online beginning Oct 1^{st} . There will be a link on the DBA website and the Twisted Vine Page. Tickets will be \$30 + tax and will not be available the day of event.

As a stop, you need to provide:

- Provide refreshments for your guests and easy access to your pouring spot
- A pitcher of water, a dump container, waist basket, wine opener and cooling if you have a white wine or beer.
- One person needs to pour and one mark off card. Be staffed appropriately.

- Offer a raffle item. Provide a way to sign up for your raffle. It is your responsibility to call your winner and this will get them back in your store.
- You will do 1 oz pours to each person and check off the participant's card.
- Advertise the event on social media. People will dress in costume. You are encouraged to wear a costume and decorate your business.

You will pick up your beverage at the Twisted Vine. Text Kate or Dan if you want to pick up earlier than the times below.

Decorations: There will be Hayrack Rides going on during the event for transportation.

Decorate your corners with hay bales, pumpkins, etc.

Start rounding up your sip and walkers by 9:15pm and send them to the Belvedere by 9:30 for the Costume Contest. Lock your doors by 9:30pm. Liquor packed up and put away by 11:00pm.

We will give certificates for the costume winners. Spook and Sip Banners will be hung up soon all around Papillion. Live music at the Eagles.
